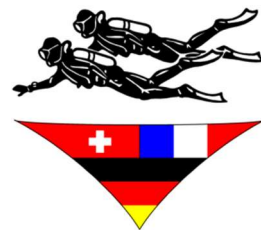

Handling of compressed air cylinders

Diving cylinders carry 200 times of their internal volume in compressed air when fully filled, i.e. a 10 l diving tank contains 2000 l of air. The air is compressed and, in case of damage to the tank, can be released explosively. Therefore, diving cylinders are considered “Dangerous Goods“ for road transportation.

Our tanks are labelled according to German standard.

Proper handling of diving tanks is part of the dive training course.

We ask you to ensure the following:

- Compressed air tanks contain compressed air.
- Carry tanks carefully, especially when on steps.
- Fasten tanks in your car to prevent them from rolling or moving.
- If the valve gets damaged or the tank overheated, it may explode.
- Do not expose tank to temperatures above 50°C.
- Ensure the tank cannot fall over. We suggest storing them horizontally.
- Adolescents under the age of 16 are not allowed to carry tanks, except when attached to a BCD.
- Please notify dive school of any damage to the valve.
- Please notify dive school, if returned tank had been filled with Nitrox.

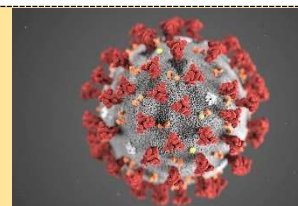

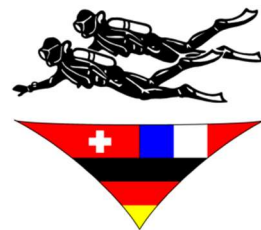

To access the internal area you need to click the padlock in the upper right corner of the screen. Then use your email address saved in our database together with your password that you can retrieve via the button 'password unknown / forgotten'. The password can be retrieved at the start of your training or club membership with us.

1. Please tell us at the start of your training, if you don't have a car and will need transport to the lakes.

2. Participation in our classes or other activities occur entirely at your own risk.
3. Teenagers under the age of 18 years need a written agreement of a legal guardian to attend any of our activities.
4. During the practical training sessions in pools or lakes the presence of a legal guardian is obligatory for teenagers under 16 years of age.
5. A booked training course must be completed within 6 months after booking.
For the extension of the training period by further 3 months a fee of 50€ will be charged (as of 2016).
6. Fees already paid will not be refunded if the training or club membership is aborted on your own initiative.
7. You commit yourself to ...
 - ... obey the instructions of our personnel during your training.
 - ... take responsibility and pay for any damages caused by yourself during your training.
 - ... to obtain a medical certificate before the start of your open water training to evidence your physical health related to all diving activities (printed forms are available from us).
 - ... pay the course fees stated in our latest price list at the same time you sign up for the course / or via bank transfer 10 days after booking at the latest.
 - ... sign up with *ProTec*, the diving association that we are part of, before the start of your course, so we can personalize your material and process your certification.
8. Participation in our scuba activities is prohibited during periods of sickness, under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication that might influence the central nerve system.
9. Safety when diving is only assured when all gear works reliably and is fully functional.
Our rental gear's condition is being checked regularly by us. Despite our scrutiny every participant using our gear is obligated to check the equipment before diving (for diver's below 14 years of age these checks will be conducted by a member of our team) and to recognize any damage to it with us before renting it out.
10. When diving with private equipment, you are responsible to keep all gear in good condition. This also refers to regular service intervals necessary to keep the gear fully functional.

11. For your training in open water some gear necessary cannot be rented from us but needs to be purchased by you (*mask, snorkel, open heel fins, gloves, neoprene shoes*).

The pickup and transport of rental equipment to the dive spot will be performed by the *lender* himself, the school will not arrange for transportation of rental equipment.

12. If rental equipment is not returned timely as agreed between lender and school, extra charges will apply.

13. In case of loss of any of our rental equipment the lender agrees to carry the cost for replacement (original price).
14. During diver's training only so-called "no decompression dives" will be performed. Considering your level of training and experience the maximum depth is limited to 40m.
15. Scuba diving is not considered a dangerous activity. Nevertheless, the risk of a diving accident can never be eliminated completely.

Please make sure to consult with your health insurance provider or accident insurance provider to verify if decompression chamber treatment is covered by the insurance policy of your holding. If this is the case, please ensure reconfirmation on a yearly basis.

If this is not the case, we can support you in finding a proper diving accident insurance.

Diver's Training

16. When beginning their training in open water, our Junior- and CMAS*-students do not need to buy any further gear except the formerly specified under No 10. Wetsuit and buoyancy device - normal size assumed - as well as tanks, regulator, and lead will be provided by us without additional cost for rental. 2* and 3* candidates can rent out needed equipment from us considering our latest price list.

17. Minimal number of lessons and open water sessions:

JUNIOR-OWD: 5 swimming pool lessons, theory class, 3 open water dives,

1*: 4 swimming pool lessons, theory class, 6 open water dives,

2* / 3*: Swimming pool check-up and assessment, theory class, min. 6 open water dives.

It is our ambition to teach you scuba diving up to a skill-level that enables you to conduct and enjoy save dives in an environment that meets or exceeds the level that we will certify you for. The number of pool sessions and open water dives stated formerly are average values emerging from our experience.

18. An excessive number of training sessions required for your certification will be charged with 15,00 € of additional cost per session (rental equipment not included).

19. Please make sure to sign up for training days or swimming pool sessions well in advance and don't forget to notify us in case of illness or being tied up with other activities.
